### Update on Congressional Bills:

### HR = in the House of Representatives

HR 2413 (formerly HR 914 / 117<sup>th</sup> Congress) ~ Dental Care for Veterans Act: This dental care bill, originally HR 96 (2019), was reintroduced in the House of Representatives on 4-14-2023 by Julia Brownley (D-CA) with currently no co-sponsors. Please call your Congressman/woman today to request their co-sponsorship. This bill expands eligibility for veterans for dental care provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). Specifically, the bill makes all veterans who are enrolled in the VA health care system eligible for VA-provided dental services. Currently, only veterans who have a service-connected dental issue or meet other narrow criteria are eligible for certain dental services.

The bill phases in eligibility over four years based upon existing eligibility, degree of service-connected disability or other disability, prisoner of war status, award of Purple Heart, financial need, or VA health care eligibility.

Call 866-220-0044 Toll Free number to Congress: Either a live operator or automated voice will ask you for your zip code and then give you options of the congressman whose district includes that zip code. When you are connected to your congressman, ask for the legislative aide and tell them you request that your congressman co-sponsor Bill HR 2413. Please contact family and friends out of state and other veterans' organizations to which you may belong regarding this bill: we need co-sponsors. Help us get the word out. And make that phone call now!

HR 2413 would furnish dental care in the same manner as medical care in the VA.
