<u>Legislative Update</u>: HR Bill 2413 Dental Care for Veterans Act was introduced in the 118th Congress by Julia Brownley (CA) on 3-30-2023. There is a new Congress in January 2025 so we await results of this important bill to be reintroduced. We will then request our members and friends of veterans to contact Congress once again. National Veterans Art Museum: VP Steve and Director Francine attended a conversation with artist Steven Luu: A Path to Healing & Transformation last month at the Chicago museum. Steven Luu, USAF medic and wounded veteran with both childhood and military trauma, creates sculptural installations using concrete, epoxy resin, and medication bottles, among other materials, to express his "second battlefield in the heart". This exhibit is "for those who still struggle"; Steven continues to process his art every time he completes a piece and wishes other vets to "honor their emotions". He shared that "making art 19 hours a day saved my life" as a patient at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. Steven feels that the National Veterans Art Museum provides a safe place for veterans: he offers others ~ both vets and civilians~ access to healing with his own life testimony.
